ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

The Detroit Department of Health and Wellness Promotion, Bureau of Substance Abuse Prevention, Treatment and Recovery (DHWP/BSAPTR) through its Fiduciary (Clark Associates), hereby solicits proposals from organizations to provide substance abuse (alcohol, tobacco and other drugs) Block Grant prevention, treatment and recovery services and Medicaid funded treatment and recovery services throughout the city of Detroit.

In response to the need for successful development of the infrastructure needed for a community-based, public health approach leading to effective and sustainable reductions in alcohol, tobacco, and other drug (ATOD) use and abuse, DHWP/BSAPTR will deploy implementation of evidence-based Center for Substance Abuse Prevention (CSAP) Strategies which influences environmental change in an effort to reduce the onset of ATOD use and abuse.

Prospective bidders can provide one or more of the following services:

Prevention:

- Education
- Information Dissemination
- Environmental Change
- Problem ID and Referral
- Community Based Change
- Alternative strategies (limited)

Treatment:

- Residential (intensive, therapeutic and recovery)
- Residential Detoxification Sub-Acute
- Intensive Outpatient
- Outpatient (Drug Free)
- Outpatient with Medication (Methadone and Buprenorphine)

All of the above treatment modalities must include recovery support services.

TARGET POPULATION: All eligible indigent youth and adult residents of the City of Detroit, specifically those who are racially and culturally diverse, physically challenged

and/or deaf/hearing impaired. Bidding organizations must serve the cultural, linguistic, mental and physical needs of targeted clients.

Prevention services must be provided at sites within the City of Detroit.

The RFP application will be available at <https://www.tricitie.org> beginning February 10, 2010 and ending on March 19, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. EST.

There will be a **Pre-Bid meeting on February 18, 2010, 10:00 am to 12 noon in the basement auditorium of the Detroit Department of Health and Wellness Promotion (DHWP), Herman Kiefer Complex, 1151 Taylor, Detroit, MI 48202.** This pre-bid meeting will be held to answer questions from prospective bidders about the RFP documents (including scopes of services).

Bids must be submitted on line, at <https://www.tricitie.org> by **March 19, 2010 @ 4:00 p.m. EST.** A Review Panel will review the proposals using select criteria with weighted scoring. Awards will be announced no later than May 31, 2010.

The contract shall automatically be renewed yearly through September 30, 2013 unless otherwise terminated. Yearly contract renewals are contingent on continued funding by the DHWP/BSAPTR and/or other State agencies responsible for substance abuse services for the Detroit Coordinating Agency area. Contracts are awarded on merit. It is noted that the Bureau of Substance Abuse Prevention Treatment and Recovery reserves the right to waive any irregularity in any proposal, and to reject any and all proposals if deemed in the best interest of the City of Detroit.

Bidders who receive a contract SHALL COMPLY WITH FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL REQUIREMENTS FOR: Equal Opportunity/Non-Discrimination; Fair Labor Practices; Licensing; Financial Controls and Audits; and Insurance. Local minority preferences may apply. Successful bidders will also be required to meet and fulfill City of Detroit ordinances and requirements. **Bidders must have a Treatment and/or Prevention License from the State of Michigan Department of Community Health as well as a current accreditation certificate prior to submission of bid.** A site visit will be conducted by the BSAPTR prior to awarding a contract.
